
2. Connecting the Rear Cables and Connectors

②	Alternate console cable	Alternate console/printer port	
③	SCSI terminator	SCSI port	SCSI terminator can be ordered separately
④	System power cord	System power socket	Yellow label indicates factory default




3. Checking the Alternate Console Switch Position

Check to make sure that the alternate console switch, marked S3, is in the down position as shown.



4. Connecting to Power Outlet



Make sure that the system unit power On/Off switch is in the off (O) position before plugging the other end of the power cord into a power outlet of the correct voltage. Check your connections as shown.



5. Starting the System

Turn on the system in the following order:

1. Terminal or printer
2. Any expansion box
3. System unit



6. Operating System Information
